PECKHAMPLEX SCHOLARSHIPS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Eligibility

To be eligible to be considered for a Peckhamplex bursary, applicants must be able to demonstrate that they:

- 1. Are a UK citizen.
- 2. Have lived in Southwark for at least 3 years.
- 3. Have attended secondary school or sixth form college in Southwark.
- 4. Have been offered a place at a UK university to undertake an undergraduate degree course.

Peckhamplex will:

- 1. Acknowledge all correctly completed applications.
- 2. Invite the front runners for an interview.
- 3. Make an offer for a Scholarship to the two finalists which will be conditional on the successful applicant taking up the offered university place.
- 4. Pay the award at the start of each academic term to the student's personal bank account (£400 term one; £300 term two; £300 term three) for three years subject to the awardee meeting the obligations below.
- 5. Respect the confidentiality of applicants' personal data.

Applicants will:

- 1. Complete and submit an online application form with supporting documents by the closing date.
- 2. Attend an interview if required.
- 3. Provide additional information or documentation if invited for an interview, such as evidence of family hardship.
- 4. If awarded the Scholarship, will provide evidence of having taken up the place.
- 5. Provide annual confirmations of continued attendance and evidence of satisfactory academic progression during the life of the course.
- 6. Inform Peckhamplex by email of any changes in circumstances which are likely to have an impact on your studies during receipt of the Scholarship.
- 7. Inform Peckhamplex by email if you drop out of the course. If so, you must repay to Peckhamplex the Scholarship monies received to date unless this requirement is waived or varied by Peckhamplex in its absolute discretion.
- 8. Agree to reasonable publicity of the award.
